DRI continues the monitoring of the implementation of the 12-point plan of the European Commission

The Democracy research institute presented opinions on the implementation of the first, second, sixth and seventh recommendations of the 12 point plan of the European Commission:

The First recommendation - Georgian Dream and part of the opposition political parties have not taken effective steps to overcome polarization, and that political polarization remains the most important challenge in terms of implementation of the recommendations of the European Commission.

The first part of the second recommendation - Despite the positive changes, there are a number of gaps in the direction of parliamentary supervision, without correcting these gaps, it will be difficult to talk about improving parliamentary supervision.

The sixth recommendation - According to the Democracy Research Institute, the Georgian Dream plan for the implementation of the 6th point was not fully in line with the spirit of the European Commission's recommendation.

The seventh recommendation - According to the assessment of the Democracy Research Institute, the Georgian Dream plan regarding the implementation of the 7th recommendation of the European Commission, which obliges the State to guarantee an independent media environment, did not comply with the requirements of the European Commission.
